Euthanasia and Chemical Capture Training

Sending two of the ACO's to euthanasia certification and seven ACO's to Chemical Capture certification. This training will allow them to euthanize using euthanasia drugs when necessary and use chemical tranquilizers in the field.

ACO's on Fire Alert over Labor Day Weekend

ACO's have been put on alert four times during the past month to respond to wildfires. During the Donner Lake Fire, the Tahoe-Vista shelter was asked to standby to receive animals if necessary. As a precaution, we have put the Tahoe shelter staff and available Auburn ACO's on standby over this busy Labor Day Weekend.
